Course Description

This course will introduce the student to diverse perspectives on healing and deliverance from Scripture and contemporary practices. Jesus healed the sick, opened the eyes of the blind, cleansed lepers, raised the dead and cast out demons—all as part of his holistic project announce the Kingdom of God. What did this ministry consist of then? What might it look like to engage in Jesus' ministry today? How can we become empowered and properly equipped to announce the Kingdom of God here and now? This course will combine careful study of key Scriptures, biblical themes and contemporary healing and deliverance approaches with hands-on prayer ministry. Following each Friday night class during each of the three weekends there will be an optional worship and ministry time for all interested.

*Course Objectives:*

1. Help the student to become familiar with Old Testament and New Testament perspectives on healing and deliverance from evil.
2. Assist the student in evaluating the biblical and theological soundness of various healing and deliverance approaches.
3. Teach the student how to use a particular model (or models) of healing and deliverance.
4. Provide students with opportunities to receive prayer for healing, deliverance and empowerment by the Spirit.

1. The student will be required to write three, two-page book reviews.

2. The student will write a final term paper on healing and/or deliverance in Scripture. A list of other possible research/writing topics will be available for those interested in pursuing more specialized topics (3,000 words). Or, the student may negotiate with the professor to do a 3,000 word research paper on a more specialized topic.

**Due: Mon., Dec 15, 2008**
